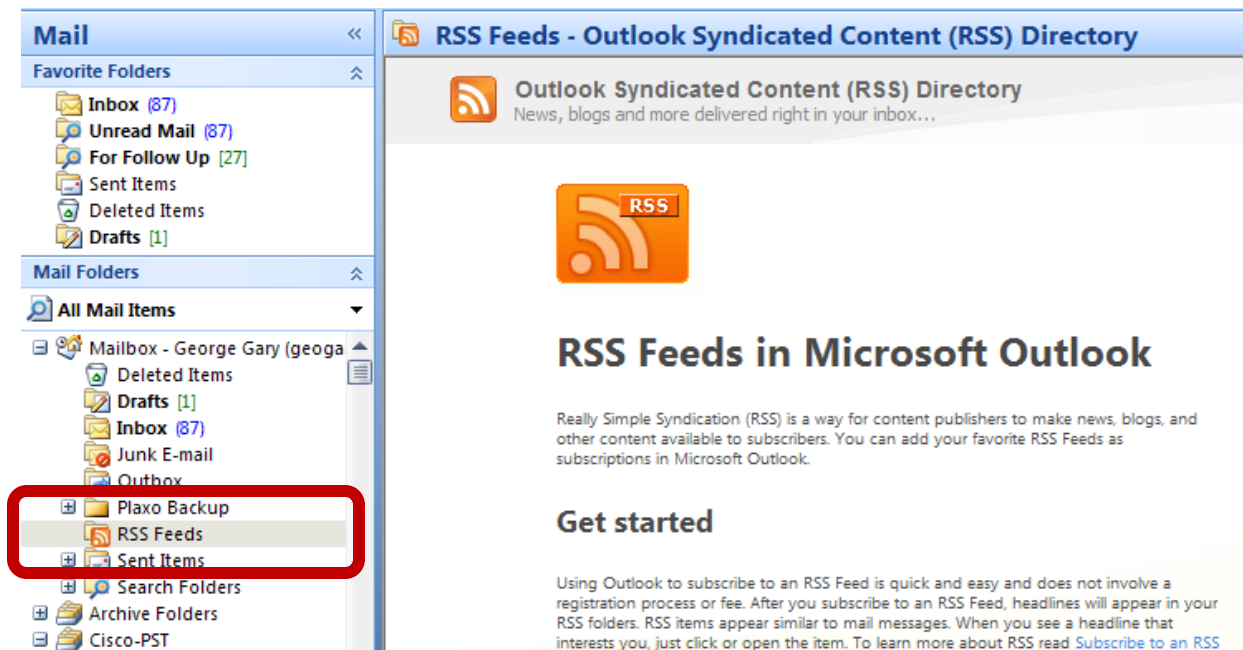

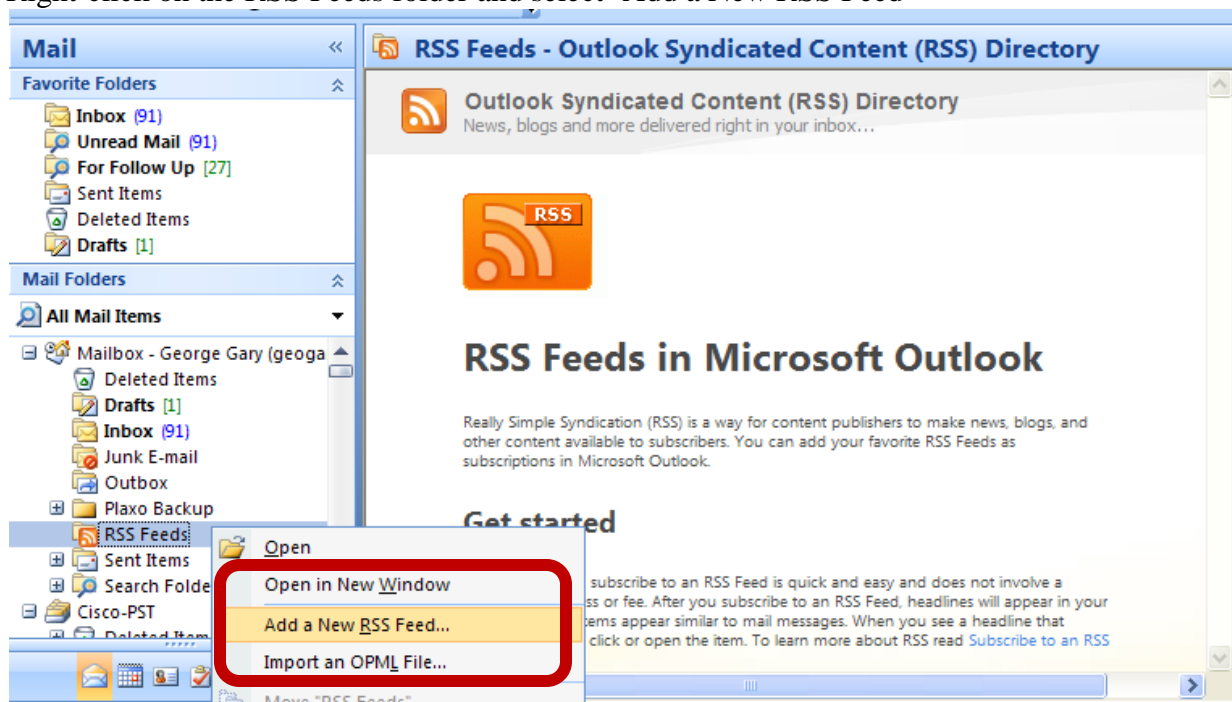

Follow these steps to read blogs and subscribe to RSS Feeds using Outlook 2007:

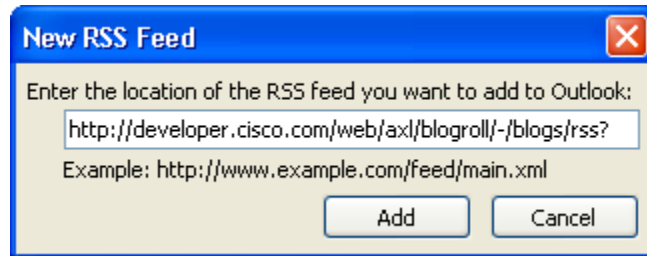
1. Open Microsoft Outlook 2007 and look for the RSS Feeds folder under Mailbox



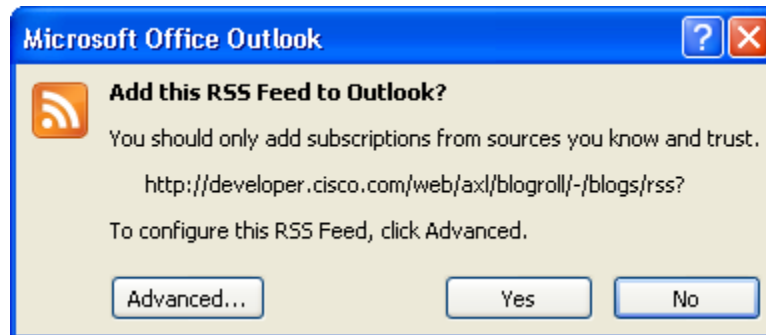
2. Right-click on the RSS Feeds folder and select 'Add a New RSS Feed'



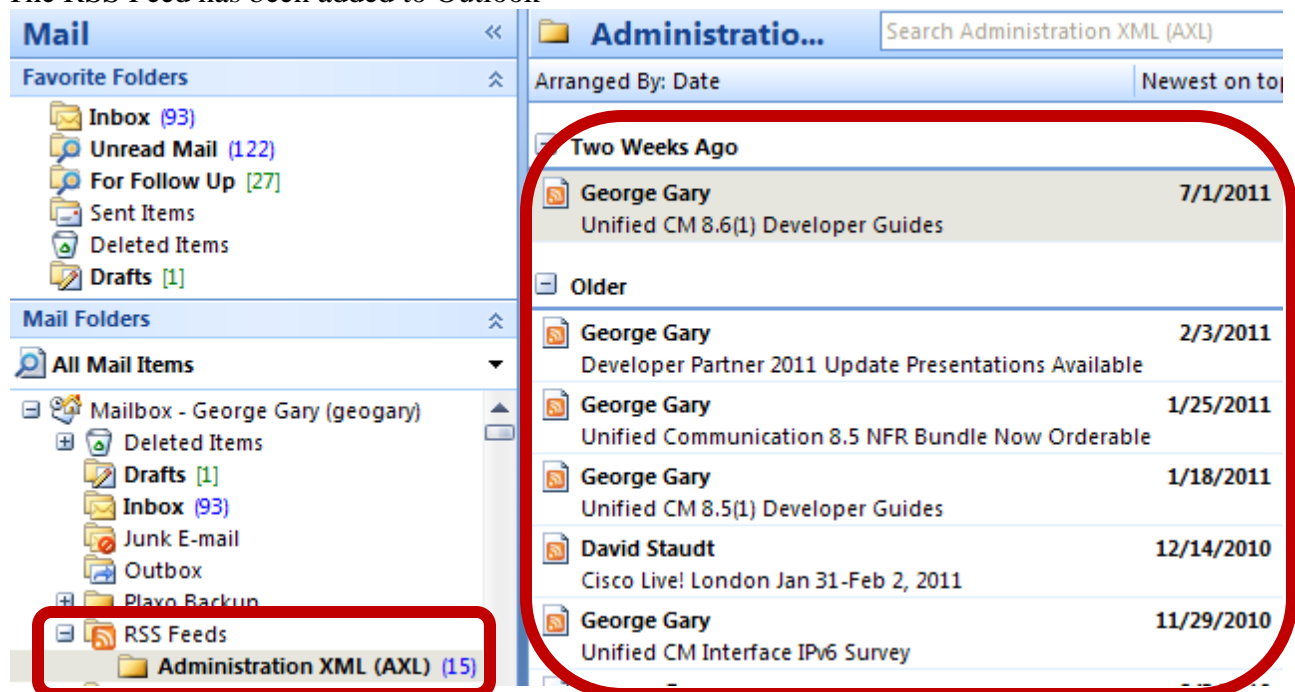
3. Enter the desired RSS Feed link found on Table 1 in this document. Click 'Add'



4. Select 'Yes' to add the RSS Feed to Outlook



5. The RSS Feed has been added to Outlook
